- (d) The Short-form and Long-form Notice of Settlement Approval Hearing will be sent to the following industry associations, in English and/or French, as is appropriate for each association, requesting voluntary distribution to their membership:
 - (i) Forest Products Association of Canada;
 - (ii) The Mining Association of Canada;
 - (iii) Ontario Mining Association;
 - (iv) Canadian Aquaculture Industry Alliance;
